FLOW MY TEARS, THE POLICEMAN SAID Announced as 2008-2009 Season Finale
Guest Director Anthony Moseley's Cast Will Feature Graduating MFA Candidates

The Theatre School at DePaul University is pleased to announce that Anthony Moseley, Executive Artistic Director of Collaboration, will direct *Flow My Tears, the Policeman Said*, written by Phillip K. Dick and adapted by Linda Hartinian, as the final installment of the 2008-2009 Season at DePaul's historic Merle Reskin Theatre.

On October 11th, 1988, 30 million viewers eagerly watch television star Jason Taverner's prime-time variety show. On October 12th, Jason Taverner is a man who has lost not only his audience, but also all proof of his existence. Based on the award-winning science fiction novel by Philip K. Dick, Linda Hartinian's adaptation explores the meaning of celebrity and the surrealities of identity, space and time. This production features the talents of the graduating class of MFA in Acting candidates.

Flow My Tears, The Policeman Said will open on May 15, 2009 (with previews on 5/13 and 5/14), and will run Wednesdays through Saturdays at 7:30pm, Sundays at 2pm, closing on May 24, 2009. All performances will be held at DePaul's historic Merle Reskin Theatre, located at 60 E. Balbo Dr., Chicago, IL 60605. Special Events include an Opening Night Party on May 15 and a post-show discussion on May 17. The performance on May 24 will be interpreted in American Sign Language.
